FIX GUIDE:

EPOXY KIT(S): IMPERFECTIONS

DESCRIPTION

THE FOLLOWING FIX GUIDE IS TO BE IMPLEMENTED WHEN THERE ARE ANY IMPERFECTIONS IN THE SURFACE OF THE EPOXY. YOU CAN IDENTIFY ISSUES LIKE THIS BY INSPECTING THE EPOXY'S SURFACE BEFORE APPLYING A TOPCOAT OR FINISHING YOUR INSTALLATION. FAILURE TO ADDRESS THESE ISSUES BEFORE THE TOPCOAT IS APPLIED MAY REQUIRE ADDITIONAL SANDING &/OR PRODUCT.

RAISED IMPERFECTIONS: THESE ISSUES CAN BE CAUSED BY NOT CLEANING THE SURFACE/AREA THOROUGHLY, GOING PAST THE WORKING TIME, OTHER PROJECTS BEING DONE, EXCESSIVE AIRFLOW FROM VENTS, WINDOW OR DOORS, ECT... AND MAY LEAVE THE SURFACE WITH BUT NOT LIMITED TO:

- THICKER SPOTS IN THE COATING
- DUST
- DEBRIS
 - HAIR
 - BUGS
 - DRYWALL

RECESSED IMPERFECTIONS: THESE ISSUES CAN BE CAUSED BY RAW/POROUS SUBSTRATES, CHEMICAL REACTIONS WITH THE SUBSTRATE OR EFFECTS USED, OVER MIXING/WORKING THE PRODUCT, APPLYING IT TOO THIN, ECT.... AND MAY LEAVE THE SURFACE WITH BUT NOT LIMITED TO:

- BUBBLES
- MISSED SPOTS
- DIVOTS
 - CLEAT MARKS
 - FOOT AND/OR PAW PRINTS

THIS GUIDE WILL GO OVER SOLUTIONS FOR BOTH TYPES OF IMPERFECTIONS AND WILL ALSO CONTAIN A SHOPPING LIST FOR THE ITEMS REQUIRED TO IMPLEMENT THEM. YOU WILL NEED TO DETERMINE WHICH OPTION(S) WORK BEST FOR YOU AND IF YOU ARE UNSURE OR HAVE ANY QUESTIONS, PLEASE CONTACT CUSTOMER SERVICE AT 844-534-4274 OR EMAIL US AT CUSTOMERSERVICE@LEGGARI.COM WHERE YOU CAN ALSO SEND/ATTACH ANY PHOTOS OF THE ISSUES THAT YOU ARE DEALING WITH, SO THAT WE CAN MAKE MORE INFORMED RECOMMENDATIONS.

PROCEDURES

- 1. INSPECT THE SURFACE AND IDENTIFY ANY IMPERFECTIONS IN THE EPOXY.
- **2.** SAND ANY IMPERFECTIONS IN THE EPOXY FLUSH WITH 220 GRIT SANDING SCREENS/PAPER.
 - **DIVOTS/RECESSES:** SAND UNTIL THE EDGE/RIM OF THE CRATER/DIVOT IS FLUSH WITH THE MAIN SURFACE OF THE EPOXY (WHEN THE GLOSSY RING DISAPPEARS YOU WILL KNOW ITS FLUSH).
 - **DUST/DEBRIS:** SAND THE HIGH SPOTS LEFT BY THE DUST/DEBRIS FLUSH WITH THE MAIN SURFACE OF THE EPOXY. MAKING SURE TO:
 - FLOOR MACHINE: DO MULTIPLE LIGHT PASSES UNTIL YOU SEE THE HIGH SPOTS FLUSHED OUT. (SITTING ON ONE SPOT FOR TOO LONG CAN HEAT UP THE EPOXY AND CAUSE IT TO GUM UP AND SMEAR ACROSS THE SURFACE).
 - ORBITAL/HAND SANDER: HOLD THE SANDER AS LEVEL AS POSSIBLE UNTIL
 THE HIGH SPOTS ARE FLUSHED OUT. (IF YOU EDGE OR HOLD THE SANDER AT
 AN ANGLE YOU RISK DIGGING THROUGH THE EPOXY AROUND THE
 IMPERFECTION AND EXPOSING THE SUBSTRATE).
- **3.** VACUUM/CLEAN THE DUST OFF OF THE SURFACE, MAKING SURE THAT NONE OF THE DUST HAS BUILT UP IN ANY OF THE LOWS SPOTS LEFT BY THE IMPERFECTIONS OR ALONG THE WALL AND/OR TRIM.
- **4.** SPRAY AND WIPE THE SURFACE DOWN WITH DENATURED ALCOHOL. (YOU SHOULD BE ABLE TO WIPE YOU HAND ACROSS THE SURFACE WITHOUT ANY RESIDUE COMING UP WITH ON IT).
- FLOORS: USE A NEW/CLEAN 3 GAL. WEED SPRAYER, AND A MICROFIBER MOP.
- COUNTERTOPS: USE A NEW/CLEAN HAND SPRAYER, AND MICROFIBER RAG.
- IF RAISED IMPERFECTIONS WERE THE ONLY ISSUES IN THE COATING, YOU MAY SKIP STEPS (5 9) AS THEY ARE SPECIFIC TO RECESSED IMPERFECTIONS.
- **5.** INSPECT THE RECESSES FOR ANY THAT STAND OUT FROM THE OTHERS AND MARK THEM WITH A PIECE OF TAPE. (OUR MAIN CONCERNS ARE SPOTS THAT ARE DOWN TO THE PRIMER OR BUBBLE CRATERS THAT HAVE A PINHOLE OR CAVITY CAUSED BY THE SUBSTRATE).

PROCEDURES (CONTINUED)

- **6.** FILL THE LOW SPOTS USING THE JB WELD EPOXY SYRINGES WITH THE STATIC MIXER ATTACHED TO INJECT THE EPOXY DIRECTLY INTO EACH OF THE RECESSES. (MAKE SURE IT IS EITHER FLUSH OR A LITTLE HIGHER THAN THE MAIN SURFACE).
- RECESSIONS MARKED WITH TAPE: THE AREAS THAT YOU MARKED WITH TAPE
 MAY REQUIRE YOU TO FILL THEM WITH EPOXY THAT HAS BEEN COLORED WITH
 OUR METALLICS TO MAKE SURE THE SUBSTRATE AND/OR PRIMER IS NO LONGER
 VISIBLE.
- PIGMENTED WHITE: IF THE SPOTS YOU ARE FILLING ARE IN AN AREA WITH OUR SOLID WHITE, THEN YOU WILL NEED TO DO THEM WITH OUR WHITE RESIN OR YOU CAN ALSO USE JB WELD MARINE-WELD WHITE. (DOING THESE WITH CLEAR RESIN WILL SHOW AMBERING/DISCOLORING MUCH MORE THAN THE WHITE).
- 7. INSPECT THE SURFACE TO MAKE SURE YOU DIDN'T MISS ANY OF THE IMPERFECTIONS.
- 8. WAIT 2-3 HRS
- **9.** SAND THE PATCHES WITH 220 GRIT SANDPAPER IN A CIRCULAR MOTION UNTIL FLUSH WITH THE MAIN SURFACE.
- 10. VACUUM/CLEAN THE DUST OFF OF THE SURFACE.
- 11. SPRAY AND WIPE THE SURFACE DOWN WITH DENATURED ALCOHOL. (YOU SHOULD BE ABLE TO WIPE YOU HAND ACROSS THE SURFACE WITHOUT ANY RESIDUE COMING UP WITH ON IT).
- FLOORS: USE A NEW/CLEAN 3 GAL. WEED SPRAYER, AND A MICROFIBER MOP.
- COUNTERTOPS: USE A NEW/CLEAN HAND SPRAYER. AND MICROFIBER RAG.
- 12. INSPECT THE SURFACE TO MAKE SURE ALL PATCHES HAVE BEEN SANDED FLUSH.
- **13.** APPLY THE TOPCOAT ORDERED WITH YOUR KIT FOLLOWING THE TUTORIAL VIDEO AND/OR INSTALLATION GUIDE FOR SAID PRODUCT.

MOST OF THESE ITEMS CAN BE FOUND AT HOME DEPOT, LOWES, ACE HARDWARE, MENARDS, SHERWIN WILLIAMS OR YOUR LOCAL HOME IMPROVEMENT STORE. IF SOME ITEMS AREN'T AVAILABLE LOCALLY YOU MAY NEED TO PURCHASE THEM ONLINE. MANY IF NOT ALL OF THESE ITEMS ARE AVAILABLE ON AMAZON.COM AS WELL (PACK QUANTITIES MAY VARY).

SOME OF THE ITEMS LISTED MAY HAVE ALREADY BEEN PURCHASED BASED ON A SEPARATE LEGGARI PRODUCTS SHOPPING LIST PERTAINING TO YOUR INSTALLATION. MAKE SURE TO CROSS REFERENCE EACH LEGGARI SHOPPING LIST YOU MAY BE USING. TO MAKE SURE YOU ARE NOT BUYING REDUNDANT ITEMS.

WHEN IMPLEMENTING THIS FIX FOR A KIT WITH A WHITE BASE COLOR OR HIGHLIGHT YOU WILL NOT WANT TO FILL ANY LOW SPOTS/RECESSES WITH CLEAR RESIN OR THIS WILL SHOW AMBERING/YELLOWING IN THE CLEAR AREAS. MAKE SURE TO USE EITHER OUR RESIN AND WHITE PIGMENT OR THE JB WELD MARINE WELD SPECCED BELOW.

AFTER MIXING THE PRODUCT YOU WILL THEN PULL IT O AND APPLY IT WITH A MEDICAL SYRINGE. USING ARE EPOXY FOR THE CHES, WILL REQUIRE 12-24 HRS BEFORE YOU ARE ABLE TO SAND, AND YOU ST ADJUST FOR THIS IN STEPS 5-8.
